Jeremiah 32:31... For this city, from the day that they built it, clear down to this day, has proved to be nothing but a cause of anger in me and a cause of rage in me, in order to remove it from before my face.

- It was then that Solomon proceeded to build a high place to Chemosh the disgusting thing of Moab on the mountain that was in front of Jerusalem, and to Molech the disgusting thing of the sons of Ammon. (1 Kings 11:7)
- And he built altars in the house of Yehowah, respecting which Yehowah had said; In Jerusalem I shall put my name. (2 Kings 21:4)
- Woe to her that is rebelling and polluting herself, the oppressive city! (Zephaniah 3:1)
- But Yehowah said; Judah, too, I shall remove from my sight, just as I have removed Israel, and I shall certainly reject this city that I have chosen, even Jerusalem, and the house of which I have said; My name will continue there. (2 Kings 23:27)
- It was only by the order of Yehowah that it took place against Judah, to remove it from his sight for the sins of Manasseh, according to all that he had done. (2 Kings 24:3)
- Jerusalem has committed outright sin. That is why she has become a mere abhorrent thing. All who were honoring her have treated her as something cheap, for they have seen her nakedness. She herself is also sighing and turns her back. (Lamentations 1:8)
- By a strong hand and by an arm stretched out, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (Psalms 136:12)
- And you, O son of man, take for yourself a brick, and you must put it before you and engrave upon it a city, even Jerusalem. (Ezekiel 4:1)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies has said; Just as I had in mind to do what was calamitous to you people because of your forefathers' making me indignant, Yehowah of armies has said, and I felt no regret. (Zechariah 8:14)
