Jeremiah 32:40. And I will conclude with them an indefinitely lasting covenant, that I shall not turn back from behind them, for me to do them good, and the fear of me I shall put in their heart in order not to turn aside from me.

- Incline YOUR ear and come to me. Listen, and YOUR soul will keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with YOU people an indefinitely lasting covenant respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (Isaiah 55:3)
- For I, Yehowah, am loving justice, hating robbery along with unrighteousness. And I will give their wages in trueness, and an indefinitely lasting covenant I shall conclude toward them.

 (Isaiah 61:8)
- God is indeed good to Israel, to those clean in heart. (Psalms 73:1)
- O do good, O Yehowah, to the good ones, even to the ones upright in their hearts. (Psalms 125:4)
- And I shall no longer conceal my face from them, because I will pour out my spirit upon the house of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 39:29)
- And I will give You a new heart, and a new spirit I shall put inside You, and I will take away the heart of stone from Your flesh and give You a heart of flesh. (Ezekiel 36:26)
- Who will not really fear you, Yehowah, and glorify your name, because you alone are loyal? For all the nations will come and worship before you, because your righteous decrees have been made manifest. (Revelation 15:4)
- In that case you will understand the fear of Yehowah, and you will find the very knowledge of God. (Proverbs 2:5)
- Happy is the man that is feeling dread constantly, but he that is hardening his heart will fall into calamity. (Proverbs 28:14)
- For not to time indefinite will Yehowah keep on casting off. (Lamentations 3:31)

- And I, I myself, must remember my covenant with you in the days of your youth, and I must establish for you an indefinitely lasting covenant. (Ezekiel 16:60)
- And I will conclude with them a covenant of peace, an indefinitely lasting covenant is what there will come to be with them. And I will place them and multiply them and place my sanctuary in the midst of them to time indefinite. (Ezekiel 37:26)
- Also, the cup in the same way after they had the evening meal, he saying; This cup means the New Covenant by virtue of my blood, which is to be poured out in YOUR behalf. (Luke 22:20)
