Jeremiah 32:43. And fields will certainly be bought in this land of which you people will be saying; It is a desolate waste without man and domestic animal. It has been given into the hand of the Chaldeans.

- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; So, too, it will be when there will be my four injurious acts of judgment, sword and famine and injurious wild beast and pestilence, that I shall actually send upon Jerusalem in order to cut off from it earthling man and domestic animal. (Ezekiel 14:21)
- And they will have to know that I am Yehowah when I make the land a desolate waste, even a desolation, on account of all their detestable things that they have done. (Ezekiel 33:29)
