- And I **will** put my spirit in **you**, and **you** must come to life, and I **will** settle **you** upon **your** soil, and **you will** have to know that I myself, Yehowah, have spoken and I have done it, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 37:14**)
- And I **will** make Jerusalem piles of stones, the lair of jackals, and the cities of Judah I shall make a **desolate waste, without** an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 9:11**)
- With drunkenness and grief you **will** be filled, with the cup of astonishment and of desolation, the cup of your sister Samaria. (**Ezekiel 23:33**)
- This is what Yehowah the God of Israel **has** said; Here I am turning in reverse the weapons of war that are in the **hand** of **you people**, with which **you** are fighting the king of Babylon, and the **Chaldeans** who are laying siege against **you** outside the wall, and I **will** gather them into the middle of this city. (**Jeremiah 21:4**)
- This is what Yehowah **has** said; In this place that **you people will** be **saying** is **waste without man** and **without domestic animal**, in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem that are desolated **without man** and **without** inhabitant and **without domestic animal**, there **will** yet be heard (**Jeremiah 33:10**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies **has** said; In this **waste** place **without man** and even **domestic animal** and in all its cities there **will** yet come to be the pasture ground of the shepherds who are making the flock lie down. (**Jeremiah 33:12**)
- My ways he **has** disarranged, and he makes me lie fallow. He **has** made me one laid **desolate**. (**Lamentations 3:11**)

- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **has** said; So, too, it **will** be when there **will** be my four injurious acts of judgment, sword and famine and injurious wild beast and pestilence, that I shall actually send upon Jerusalem in order to cut off from it earthling **man** and **domestic animal**. (**Ezekiel 14:21**)
- And they **will** have to know that I am Yehowah when I make the **land** a **desolate waste**, even a desolation, on account of all their detestable things that they have done. (**Ezekiel 33:29**)
