Jeremiah 32:44" With money people will buy fields themselves, and there will be a recording in the deed and a sealing and a taking of witnesses in the land of Benjamin and in the surroundings of Jerusalem and in the cities of Judah and in the cities of the mountainous region and in the cities of the lowland and in the cities of the south, because I shall bring back their captives, is the utterance of Yehowah.

- Then I wrote in a deed and affixed the seal and took witnesses as I went weighing the money in the scales. (Jeremiah 32:10)
- Yet you yourself have said to me; O Sovereign Lord Yehowah, buy for yourself the field with money and take witnesses.

 Although the city itself must be given into the hand of the Chaldeans. (Jeremiah 32:25)
- And Zelah, Ha-eleph and Jebusi, that is to say; Jerusalem, Gibeah and Kiriath, fourteen cities and their settlements. This was the inheritance of the sons of Benjamin by their families. (Joshua 18:28)
- In those days Judah will be saved and Jerusalem itself will reside in security. And this is what she will be called, Yehowah Is Our Righteousness. (Jeremiah 33:16)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; They will yet say this word in the land of Judah and in his cities, when I shall gather their captives, May Yehowah bless you, O righteous dwelling place, O holy mountain. (Jeremiah 31:23)
- In the Shephelah there were Eshtaol and Zorah and Ashnah. (Joshua 15:33)
- And people will actually come from the cities of Judah and from round about Jerusalem and from the land of Benjamin and from the lowland and from the mountainous region and from the Negeb, bringing whole burnt offering and sacrifice and grain offering and frankincense and bringing thanksgiving sacrifice into the house of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 17:26)

- In the cities of the mountainous region, in the cities of the lowland and in the cities of the south and in the land of Benjamin and in the surroundings of Jerusalem and in the cities of Judah flocks will yet pass by under the hands of the one taking the count, Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 33:13)
- And the cities at the extremity of the tribe of the sons of Judah toward the boundary of Edom in the south came to be Kabzeel and Eder and Jagur. (Joshua 15:21)
- When Yehowah gathered back the captive ones of Zion, we became like those who were dreaming. (Psalms 126:1)
- And I will bring back the captives of Judah and the captives of Israel, and I will build them just as at the start. (Jeremiah 33:7)
- Thus the field of Ephron that was in Machpelah, which is in front of Mamre, the field and the cave that was in it and all the trees that were in the field, which were within all its boundaries round about, became confirmed (Genesis 23:17)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- For, look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will gather the captive ones of my people, Israel and Judah, Yehowah has said, and I will bring them back to the land that I gave to their forefathers, and they will certainly repossess it. (Jeremiah 30:3)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Taking these deeds, this deed of purchase, even the sealed one, and the other deed left open, you must also put them into an earthenware vessel, in order that they may last for many days. (Jeremiah 32:14)
- The sound of exultation and the sound of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those saying; Laud Yehowah of armies, for Yehowah is good, for to time indefinite is his loving-kindness! They will be bringing a thanksgiving offering into the house of Yehowah, for I shall bring back the captives of the land just as at the start, Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 33:11)
- And upon YOU I will cause humankind to walk, even my people Israel, and they must take possession of YOU, and YOU must

become a hereditary possession to them, and you will not bereave them again of any more children. (Ezekiel 36:12)
