- Here is **Hanamel** the **son** of Shallum your **paternal uncle** coming in to you, saying; Buy for yourself the **field** of mine that is in **Anathoth**, because the right of repurchase belongs to you for buying it. (**Jeremiah 32:7**)
- The words of Jeremiah the **son** of Hilkiyah, one of the priests that were in **Anathoth** in the land of Benjamin. (**Jeremiah 1:1**)
- Accordingly Abraham listened to Ephron, and Abraham weighed **out** to Ephron the amount of **silver** that he had spoken in the hearing of the **sons** of Heth, four hundred **silver shekels** current with the merchants. (**Genesis 23:16**)
