

Jeremiah 33:11· The sound of exultation and the sound of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those saying; **LAUD** Yehowah of armies, for Yehowah is good, for to time indefinite is his loving-kindness!¹ They will be bringing a thanksgiving offering into the house of Yehowah, for I shall bring back the captives of the land just as at the start, Yehowah has said.

- And they **will** certainly come and cry out joyfully on the height of Zion and become radiant over the goodness of **Yehowah**, over the grain and over the new wine and over the oil and over the young ones of the flock and the cattle. And their soul **will** simply become like a well-watered garden, and no more **will** they languish again. (**Jeremiah 31:12**)
- Good and upright is **Yehowah**. That is why he instructs sinners in the way. (**Psalms 25:8**)
- For O how great his goodness is, and how great his handsomeness is! Grain is what **will** make the young men thrive, and new wine the virgins. (**Zechariah 9:17**)
- Jesus said to him; Why do you call me **good**? Nobody is **good**, except one, God. (**Mark 10:18**)
- Give thanks to **Yehowah**, **you** people, call upon his name, make his deeds known among the peoples! (**1 Chronicles 16:8**)
- And it came about that as soon as the trumpeters and the singers were as one in causing one **sound** to be heard in praising and thanking **Yehowah**, and as soon as they lifted up the **sound** with the trumpets and with the cymbals and with the instruments of song and with praising **Yehowah**, for he is **good**, for to time **indefinite** is his loving-kindness, the **house** itself was filled with a cloud, the very **house** of **Yehowah**. (**2 Chronicles 5:13**)
- And they began to respond by praising and giving thanks to **Yehowah**, for he is **good**, for his loving-kindness toward Israel is to time indefinite. As for all the people, they shouted with a loud shout in praising **Yehowah** over the laying of the foundation of the **house** of **Yehowah**. (**Ezra 3:11**)

- For I have said; Loving-kindness **will** stay built even to time **indefinite**, as for the heavens, you keep your faithfulness firmly established in them. (**Psalms 89:2**)
- And in that day **you will** certainly say; Give thanks to **Yehowah**, **you** people! Call upon his name. Make known among the peoples his dealings. Make mention that his name is put on high. (**Isaiah 12:4**)
- Who is a God like you, one pardoning error and passing over transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? He **will** certainly not hold onto his anger forever, for he is delighting in loving-kindness. (**Micah 7:18**)
- If he would present it in expression of **thanksgiving**, then he must present along with the sacrifice of **thanksgiving** unfermented ring-shaped cakes moistened with oil and unfermented wafers smeared with oil and well-mixed fine flour as ring-shaped cakes moistened with oil. (**Leviticus 7:12**)
- Finally Hezekiah answered and said; Now **you** have filled **your** hand with power for **Yehowah**. Approach, and **bring** sacrifices and **thanksgiving** sacrifices to the **house** of Yehowah. And the congregation began to **bring** sacrifices and **thanksgiving** sacrifices, and also every one willing of heart, burnt **offerings**. (**2 Chronicles 29:31**)
- And let them offer the sacrifices of **thanksgiving** and declare his works with a joyful cry. (**Psalms 107:22**)
- **Yehowah** your God **will** indeed **bring** you into the **land** of which your fathers took possession, and you **will** certainly take possession of it, and he **will** indeed do you **good** and multiply you more than your fathers. (**Deuteronomy 30:5**)
- With money people **will** buy fields themselves, and there **will** be a recording in the deed and a sealing and a taking of witnesses in the **land** of Benjamin and in the surroundings of Jerusalem and in the cities of Judah and in the cities of the mountainous region and in the cities of the lowland and in the cities of the south, because I shall **bring back** their captives, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 32:44**)
- Of Jeduthun, the sons of Jeduthun, Gedaliah and Zeri and Jeshaiiah, and Shimei, Hashabiah and Mattithiah, six, under the

- control of their father Jeduthun, who was prophesying with the harp for thanking and praising **Yehowah**. (**1 Chronicles 25:3**)
- And in the first year of Cyrus the king of Persia, that Yehowah's word from the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, **Yehowah** roused the spirit of Cyrus the king of Persia so that he caused a cry to pass through all his realm, and also in writing, **saying**; (**Ezra 1:1**)
 - And the Levites Jeshua and Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabneiah, Sherebiah, Hodiah, Shebaniah and Pethahiah went on to say; Rise, bless **Yehowah** **YOUR** God from time **indefinite** to time **indefinite**. And let them bless your glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise. (**Nehemiah 9:5**)
 - Remember your mercies, O **Yehowah**, and your loving-kindnesses, for they are from time **indefinite**. (**Psalms 25:6**)
 - Bless our God, O **YOU** peoples, and cause the **voice** of praise to him to be heard. (**Psalms 66:8**)
 - For God himself **will** save Zion and **will** build the cities of Judah, and they **will** certainly dwell there and take possession of it. (**Psalms 69:35**)
 - Will you yourself not enliven us again, that your people themselves may rejoice in you? (**Psalms 85:6**)
 - For **Yehowah** is **good**, his loving-kindness is to time **indefinite**, and his faithfulness to generation after generation. (**Psalms 100:5**)
 - At that time our mouth came to be filled with laughter, and our tongue with a joyful cry. At that time they proceeded to say among the nations; Yehowah **has** done a great thing in what he **has** done with them. (**Psalms 126:2**)
 - And who gave their **land** as an inheritance, for his loving-kindness is to time **indefinite**. (**Psalms 136:21**)
 - They themselves **will** raise their **voice**, they **will** cry out joyfully. In the superiority of **Yehowah** they **will** certainly cry out shrilly from the sea. (**Isaiah 24:14**)
 - **you** people **will** come to have a song like that in the night that one sanctifies oneself for a festival, and **rejoicing** of heart like

- that of one walking with a flute to enter into the mountain of **Yehowah**, to the Rock of Israel. (**Isaiah 30:29**)
- And the very ones redeemed by **Yehowah will** return and certainly come to Zion with a joyful cry, and **rejoicing** to time **indefinite will** be upon their head. To **exultation** and **rejoicing** they **will** attain, and grief and sighing must flee away. (**Isaiah 35:10**)
 - For **Yehowah will** certainly comfort Zion. He **will** for certain comfort all her devastated places, and he **will** make her wilderness like Eden and her desert plain like the garden of **Yehowah**. Exultation and **rejoicing** themselves **will** be found in her, **thanksgiving** and the **voice** of melody. (**Isaiah 51:3**)
 - For this is what **Yehowah has** said; Just as I have brought in upon this people all this great calamity, so I am **bringing** in upon them all the goodness that I am speaking concerning them. (**Jeremiah 32:42**)
