- As for Israel, he **will** certainly be **saved** in union with **Yehowah** with a salvation for times indefinite. **You** people **will** not be ashamed, nor **will you** be humiliated for the indefinite times of eternity. (**Isaiah 45:17**)
- And Israel **will reside** in **security**, the fountain of Jacob by itself, upon a land of grain and new wine. Yes, his heavens **will** let the dew drip down. (**Deuteronomy 33:28**)
- And they **will** actually dwell upon it in **security** and build houses and plant vineyards, and they must dwell in **security** when I execute acts of judgment upon all those treating them with scorn all round about them, and they **will** have to know that I am **Yehowah** their God. (**Ezekiel 28:26**)
- In his days **Judah will** be **saved**, and Israel itself **will reside** in **security**. And this is his name with which he **will** be **called**, **Yehowah Is Our Righteousness**. (**Jeremiah 23:6**)
- Everyone that is **called** by my name and that I have created for my own glory, that I have formed, yes, that I have made. (**Isaiah 43:7**)
- And the nations **will** certainly see your righteousness, O woman, and all kings your glory. And you **will** actually be **called** by a new name, which the very mouth of **Yehowah will** designate. (**Isaiah 62:2**)
- And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, and do not be struck with terror, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far off and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob **will** certainly return and be free of disturbance and be at ease, and there **will** be no one causing trembling. (**Jeremiah 30:10**)
- Here I am collecting them together out of all the lands to which I shall have dispersed them in my anger and in my rage and in

- great indignation, and I **will** bring them back to this place and make them dwell in **security**. (**Jeremiah 32:37**)
- With money people **will** buy fields themselves, and there **will** be a recording in the deed and a sealing and a taking of witnesses in the land of Benjamin and in the surroundings of **Jerusalem** and in the cities of **Judah** and in the cities of the mountainous region and in the cities of the lowland and in the cities of the south, because I shall bring back their captives, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 32:44**)
 - And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and do not be terror-stricken, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far away and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob **will** certainly return and have no disturbance and be at ease and without anyone causing trembling. (**Jeremiah 46:27**)
 - And I **will** conclude with them a covenant of peace, and I shall certainly cause the injurious wild beast to cease out of the land, and they **will** actually dwell in the wilderness in **security** and sleep in the forests. (**Ezekiel 34:25**)
 - This is **what Yehowah** has said; I **will** return to Zion and **reside** in the midst of **Jerusalem**, and **Jerusalem will** certainly be **called** the city of trueness, and the mountain of **Yehowah** of armies, the holy mountain. (**Zechariah 8:3**)
 - And people **will** certainly inhabit her, and there **will** occur no more any banning to destruction, and **Jerusalem** must be inhabited in **security**. (**Zechariah 14:11**)
