Jeremiah 33:17... For this is what Yehowah has said; There will not be cut off in David's case a man to sit upon the throne of the house of Israel.

- And your house and your kingdom will certainly be steadfast to time indefinite before you, your very throne will become one firmly established to time indefinite. (2 Samuel 7:16)
- In order that Yehowah may carry out his word that he spoke respecting me, saying; If your sons will take care of their way by walking before me in truth with all their heart and with all their soul, there will not be cut off a man of yours from sitting upon the throne of Israel. (1 Kings 2:4)
