- And God proceeded to make the two great luminaries, the greater luminary for dominating the **day** and the lesser luminary for dominating the **night**, and also the stars. (**Genesis 1:16**)
- This is **what Yehowah has said**; If **you** people could break my **covenant** of the **day** and my **covenant** of the **night**, even in order for **day** and **night** not to occur in their time. (**Jeremiah 33:20**)
- Have you come to know the **statutes** of the **heavens**, or could you put its authority in the **earth**? (**Job 38:33**)
- To you the **day** belongs, also, to you the **night** belongs. You yourself prepared the luminary, even the sun. (**Psalms 74:16**)
- He **has** made the moon for **appointed** times, the sun itself knows well where it sets. (**Psalms 104:19**)
- This is **what Yehowah**, the Giver of the sun for light by **day**, the **statutes** of the moon and the stars for light by **night**, the One stirring up the sea that its waves may become boisterous, the One whose name is **Yehowah** of armies, **has said**. (**Jeremiah 31:35**)
- And they must serve as luminaries in the expanse of the **heavens** to shine upon the earth. And it came to be so. (**Genesis 1:15**)
- And he keeps them standing forever, to time indefinite. A regulation he **has** given, and it will not pass away. (**Psalms 148:6**)
- Incline **YOUR** ear and come to me. Listen, and **YOUR** soul will keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with **you** people an indefinitely lasting **covenant** respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (**Isaiah 55:3**)
