- And to Babylon he will take Zedekiah, and there he will continue until I turn my attention to him, is the utterance of Yehowah, although **you men** keep warring **against** the **Chaldeans**, **you** will not succeed? (**Jeremiah 32:5**)
- At that my **anger** will indeed blaze **against** them in that day, and I shall certainly forsake them and conceal my **face** from them, and they must become something to be consumed, and many calamities and distresses must come upon them, and they will be bound to say in that day, Is it not because our God is not in our midst that these calamities **have** come upon us? (**Deuteronomy 31:17**)
- For I **have** set my **face against** this **city** for calamity and not for good, is the utterance of Yehowah. Into the hand of the king of Babylon it will be given, and he will certainly burn it with fire. (**Jeremiah 21:10**)
- At that time they will call to Yehowah for aid, but he will not answer them. And he will conceal his **face** from them in that time, according as they committed **badness** in their dealings. (**Micah 3:4**)
- This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; Here I am turning in reverse the weapons of war that are in the hand of **you** people, with which **you** are fighting the king of Babylon, and the **Chaldeans** who are laying siege **against you** outside the wall, and I will gather them into the middle of this **city**. (**Jeremiah 21:4**)
- And by a great military force and by a multitudinous congregation Pharaoh will not make him effective in the war, by throwing up a siege rampart and by building a siege wall, in order to cut off many souls. (**Ezekiel 17:17**)
