- And Yehowah your God **will** indeed make you have more than enough in every work of your hand, in the fruit of your belly and the fruit of your domestic animals and the fruitage of your soil, resulting in prosperity, because Yehowah **will** again exult over you for good, just as he exulted over your forefathers. (**Deuteronomy 30:9**)
- Yehowah has done a great thing in what he has done with us. We have **become** joyful. (**Psalms 126:3**)
- And you must **become** a crown of **beauty** in the hand of Yehowah, and a kingly turban in the palm of your God. (**Isaiah 62:3**)
- And do not give him any silence until he fixes solidly, yes, until he sets Jerusalem as a **praise** in the **earth**. (**Isaiah 62:7**)
- And the **dread** of God came to be upon all the kingdoms of the lands when they heard that Yehowah had fought against the enemies of Israel. (**2 Chronicles 20:29**)
- They **will** lick up dust like the serpents, like reptiles of the **earth** they **will** come in agitation out of their bulwarks. To Yehowah our God they **will** come quivering, and they **will** be afraid of you. (**Micah 7:17**)
- And it came about that, as soon as all our enemies heard of it and all the **nations** that were around us got to see it, they at once fell very much in their own eyes, and they got to know that it was from our God that this work had been done. (**Nehemiah 6:16**)
- For there is the true forgiveness with you, in order that you may be feared. (**Psalms 130:4**)
- Instead of the thicket of thorns the juniper tree **will** come up. Instead of the stinging nettle the myrtle tree **will** come up. And

- it must **become** for Yehowah something famous, a sign to time indefinite that **will** not be cut off. (**Isaiah 55:13**)
- At that time you **will** see and **certainly become** radiant, and your heart **will** actually quiver and expand, because to you the wealthiness of the sea **will** direct itself, the very resources of the **nations will** come to you. (**Isaiah 60:5**)
 - For just as a belt clings to the hips of a man, so I caused the whole house of Israel and the whole house of Judah to cling even to me, is the utterance of Yehowah, in order to **become** to me a people and a **name** and a **praise** and something beautiful, but they did not obey. (**Jeremiah 13:11**)
 - Afterwards the sons of Israel **will** come back and **certainly** look for Yehowah their God, and for David their king, and they **will certainly** come quivering to Yehowah and to his **goodness** in the final part of the days. (**Hosea 3:5**)
 - At that time I shall bring **you** people in, even in the time of my collecting **you** together. For I shall make **you** people to be a **name** and a **praise** among all the peoples of the **earth**, when I gather back **your** captive ones before **your** eyes, Yehowah has said. (**Zephaniah 3:20**)
