Jeremiah 34:10. So all the princes obeyed, and all the people who had entered into the covenant to let each one his manservant and each one his maidservant go free, in order to use them no more as servants, and they proceeded to obey and to let them go.

- In time the princes of Judah got to hear these words, and they proceeded to come up from the house of the king to the house of Yehowah and to sit down in the entrance of the new gate of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 26:10)
- At that he went down to the house of the king, to the dining room of the secretary, and, look! There is where all the princes were sitting, Elishama the secretary and Delaiah the son of Shemaiah and Elnathan the son of Achbor and Gemariah the son of Shaphan and Zedekiah the son of Hananiah and all the other princes. (Jeremiah 36:12)
- And in case your brother grows poor alongside you and he has to sell himself to you, you must not use him as a worker in slavish service. (Leviticus 25:39)
