- Finally he took the book of the **covenant** and read it in the ears of the people. Then they **said**; All that **Yehowah** has spoken we are willing to do and be obedient. (**Exodus 24:7**)
- **Yehowah** our **God** concluded a **covenant** with us in Horeb. (**Deuteronomy 5:2**)
- But it was because of Yehowah's loving **YOU**, and because of his keeping the sworn statement that he had sworn to **YOUR forefathers**, that **Yehowah** brought **you out** with a strong hand, that he might redeem you from the **house** of slaves, from the hand of Pharaoh the king of **Egypt**. (**Deuteronomy 7:8**)
- And you must remember that you became a slave in **Egypt**, and **Yehowah** your **God** proceeded to redeem you from there. That is why I am commanding you to do this thing. (**Deuteronomy 24:18**)
- And Moses went on to say to the people; Let there be a remembering of this **day** on which **you** went **out** of **Egypt**, from the **house** of slaves, because by strength of hand **Yehowah** brought **you out** from here. So nothing leavened may be eaten. (**Exodus 13:3**)
