- Finally he took the book of the covenant and read it in the ears of the people. Then they said; All that Yehowah has spoken we are willing to do and be obedient. (Exodus 24:7)
- Yehowah our God concluded a covenant with us in Horeb. (Deuteronomy 5:2)
- But it was because of Yehowah's loving YOU, and because of his keeping the sworn statement that he had sworn to YOUR forefathers, that Yehowah brought YOU out with a strong hand, that he might redeem YOU from the house of slaves, from the hand of Pharaoh the king of Egypt. (Deuteronomy 7:8)
- Yehowah your God proceeded to redeem you from there. That is why I am commanding you to do this thing. (Deuteronomy 24:18)
- And Moses went on to say to the people; Let there be a remembering of this day on which you went out of Egypt, from the house of slaves, because by strength of hand Yehowah brought you out from here. So nothing leavened may be eaten. (Exodus 13:3)
