

Jeremiah 34:14 At the end of seven years you men should let go each one his brother, a Hebrew man, who came to be sold to you and who has served you six¹ years, and you must let him go free from being with you. But your forefathers did not listen to me, neither did they incline their ear.

- In case you should buy a Hebrew slave, he will be a slave six years, but in the seventh he will go out as one set free without charge. (Exodus 21:2)
- And he must go out from you, he and his sons with him, and he must return to his family, and he should return to the possession of his forefathers. (Leviticus 25:41)
- In case there should be sold to you your brother, a Hebrew or a Hebrewess, and he has served you six years, then in the seventh year you should send him out from you as one set free. (Deuteronomy 15:12)
- And in case your brother grows poor alongside you and he has to sell himself to you, you must not use him as a worker in slavish service. (Leviticus 25:39)
- In accord with all their doings that they have done from the day of my bringing them up out of Egypt until this day in that they kept leaving me and serving other gods, that is the way they are doing also to you. (1 Samuel 8:8)
- And they did not listen but kept hardening their necks like the necks of their forefathers that had not exercised faith in Yehowah their God. (2 Kings 17:14)
- Although you would bear witness against them to bring them back to your law, they themselves even acted presumptuously and did not listen to your commandments, and against your own judicial decisions they sinned, which, if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. And they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their neck they hardened, and they did not listen. (Nehemiah 9:29)

- But they did not **listen** to me, and they did not **incline** their **ear**, but they kept hardening their neck. They acted worse than their **forefathers!** (**Jeremiah 7:26**)
- And their heart they set as an emery stone to keep from obeying the Law and the words that Yehowah of armies sent by his spirit, by means of the former prophets, so that there occurred great indignation on the part of Yehowah of armies. (**Zechariah 7:12**)
