- In case you should buy a Hebrew slave, he will be a slave six years, but in the seventh he will go out as one set free without charge. (**Exodus 21:2**)
- And **you** must sanctify the fiftieth year and **proclaim liberty** in the land to all its inhabitants. It will become a Jubilee for **you**, and **you** must return each one to his possession and **you** should return each one to his family. (**Leviticus 25:10**)
- In case there should be sold to you your brother, a Hebrew or a Hebrewess, and he has served you six years, then in the seventh year you should send him out from you as one set free. (**Deuteronomy 15:12**)
- Is not this the fast that I choose? To loosen the fetters of wickedness, to release the bands of the yoke bar, and to send away the crushed ones free, and that **you people** should tear in two every yoke bar? (**Isaiah 58:6**)
- The spirit of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** is upon me, for the reason that **Yehowah** has anointed me to tell Good News to the meek ones. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to **proclaim liberty** to those taken captive and the wide opening of the eyes even to the prisoners. (**Isaiah 61:1**)
