

**Jeremiah 35:13**•• **This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Go, and you must say to the men of<sup>1</sup> Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem; Did you not continually receive exhortation to obey my words? Is the utterance of Yehowah.**

**Footnote:** To the men of Hebrew, *le'ish*, singular but used collectively

[5] - References:

- If only they would develop this heart of theirs to fear me and to keep all my commandments always, in order that it might go well with them and their sons to time indefinite! (**Deuteronomy 5:29**)
- Be corrected, O **Jerusalem**, that my soul may not turn away disgusted from you, that I may not set you as a desolate waste, a land not inhabited. (**Jeremiah 6:8**)
- This is **what Yehowah** of **armies**, the **God** of **Israel**, **has said**; Make **YOUR** ways and **YOUR** dealings good, and I will keep **YOU** people residing in this place. (**Jeremiah 7:3**)
- Who is the man that is wise, that he may understand this, even the one to whom the mouth of **Yehowah** **has** spoken, that he may tell it? On **what** account should the land actually perish, be actually burned like the wilderness without anyone passing through? (**Jeremiah 9:12**)
- And they kept turning to me the back and not the face, though there was a teaching of them, a rising up early and teaching, but there were none of them listening to **receive** discipline. (**Jeremiah 32:33**)
