Jeremiah 35:17... Therefore this is what Yehowah, the God of armies, the God of Israel, has said, Here I am bringing upon Judah and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem all the calamity that I have spoken against them, for the reason that I have spoken to them but they did not listen, and I kept calling to them but they did not answer.

- And it must occur that if you will not listen to the voice of Yehowah your God by taking care to do all his commandments and his statutes that I am commanding you today, all these maledictions must also come upon you and overtake you. (Deuteronomy 28:15)
- Then Yehowah's anger blazed against that land by bringing upon it the whole malediction written in this book. (Deuteronomy 29:27)
- And it must occur that, just as all the good word that Yehowah YOUR God has spoken to YOU has come upon YOU, so Yehowah will bring upon YOU all the evil word until he has annihilated YOU from off this good ground that Yehowah YOUR God has given YOU. (Joshua 23:15)
- But Yehowah said; Judah, too, I shall remove from my sight, just as I have removed Israel, and I shall certainly reject this city that I have chosen, even Jerusalem, and the house of which I have said, My name will continue there. (2 Kings 23:27)
- And I will commission over them four families, is the utterance of Yehowah, the sword to kill, and the dogs to drag away, and the flying creatures of the heavens and the beasts of the earth to eat and to bring to ruin. (Jeremiah 15:3)
- Therefore on account of You men Zion will be plowed up as a mere field, and Jerusalem herself will become mere heaps of ruins, and the mountain of the house will be as the high places of a forest. (Micah 3:12)
- Because I have called out but You keep refusing, I have stretched out my hand but there is no one paying attention. (Proverbs 1:24)

- And I will destine you men to the sword, and you will all of you bow down to being slaughtered, for the reason that I called, but you did not answer, I spoke, but you did not listen, and you kept doing what was bad in my eyes, and the thing in which I took no delight you chose. (Isaiah 65:12)
- I myself, in turn, shall choose ways of ill-treating them, and the things frightful to them I shall bring upon them, for the reason that I called, but there was no one answering, I spoke, but there were none that listened, and they kept on doing what was bad in my eyes, and the thing in which I took no delight they chose. (Isaiah 66:4)
- And now for the reason that you kept doing all these works, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I kept speaking to you, getting up early and speaking, but you did not listen, and I kept calling you, but you did not answer. (Jeremiah 7:13)
- By listening to the words of my servants the prophets, whom I am sending to You, even rising up early and sending them, whom You have not listened to. (Jeremiah 26:5)
- And they kept turning to me the back and not the face, though there was a teaching of them, a rising up early and teaching, but there were none of them listening to receive discipline. (Jeremiah 32:33)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Here I am bringing calamity upon this place and its inhabitants, all the curses that are written in the book that they read before the king of Judah. (2 Chronicles 34:24)
- And you are righteous as regards all that has come upon us, for faithfully is how you have acted, but we are the ones that have done wickedly. (Nehemiah 9:33)
- And I will call to account against him and against his offspring and against his servants their error, and I will bring upon them and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem and upon the men of Judah all the calamity that I have spoken against them, and they did not listen. (Jeremiah 36:31)
- So my rage, and my anger, was poured out and it burned in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, and they came to be a devastated place, a desolate waste, as at this day. (Jeremiah 44:6)
