

**Jeremiah 35:17** **Therefore this is what Yehowah, the God of armies, the God of Israel, has said, Here I am bringing upon Judah and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem all the calamity that I have spoken against them, for the reason that I have spoken to them but they did not listen, and I kept calling to them but they did not answer.**

- And it must occur that if you will not **listen** to the voice of **Yehowah** your **God** by taking care to do all his commandments and his statutes that I **am** commanding you today, all these maledictions must also come upon you and overtake you. (**Deuteronomy 28:15**)
- Then Yehowah's anger blazed **against** that land by **bringing** upon it the whole malediction written in this book. (**Deuteronomy 29:27**)
- And it must occur that, just as all the good word that **Yehowah YOUR God has spoken** to **YOU** **has** come upon **YOU**, so **Yehowah** will bring upon **YOU** all the evil word until he **has** annihilated **YOU** from off this good ground that **Yehowah YOUR God has** given **YOU**. (**Joshua 23:15**)
- But **Yehowah said**; Judah, too, I shall remove from my sight, just as I **have** removed **Israel**, and I shall certainly reject this city that I **have** chosen, even **Jerusalem**, and the house of which I **have said**, My name will continue there. (**2 Kings 23:27**)
- And I will commission over them four families, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, the sword to kill, and the dogs to drag away, and the flying creatures of the heavens and the beasts of the earth to eat and to bring to ruin. (**Jeremiah 15:3**)
- Therefore on account of **YOU** men Zion will be plowed up as a mere field, and **Jerusalem** herself will become mere heaps of ruins, and the mountain of the house will be as the high places of a forest. (**Micah 3:12**)
- Because I **have** called out but **YOU** keep refusing, I **have** stretched out my hand but there is no one paying attention. (**Proverbs 1:24**)

- And I will destine **you** men to the sword, and **you** will all of **you** bow down to being slaughtered, for the **reason** that I called, but **you** did not answer, I spoke, but **you** did not **listen**, and **you kept** doing **what** was bad in my eyes, and the thing in which I took no delight **you** chose. (**Isaiah 65:12**)
- I myself, in turn, shall choose ways of ill-treating them, and the things frightful to them I shall bring upon them, for the **reason** that I called, but there was no one answering, I spoke, but there were none that listened, and they **kept** on doing **what** was bad in my eyes, and the thing in which I took no delight they chose. (**Isaiah 66:4**)
- And now for the **reason** that **you kept** doing all these works, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, and I **kept** speaking to **you**, getting up early and speaking, but **you** did not **listen**, and I **kept calling you**, but **you** did not answer. (**Jeremiah 7:13**)
- By listening to the words of my servants the prophets, whom I **am** sending to **you**, even rising up early and sending them, whom **you have** not listened to. (**Jeremiah 26:5**)
- And they **kept** turning to me the back and not the face, though there was a teaching of them, a rising up early and teaching, but there were none of them listening to receive discipline. (**Jeremiah 32:33**)
- This is **what Yehowah has said**; **Here I am bringing calamity** upon this place and its **inhabitants**, all the curses that are written in the book that they read before the king of **Judah**. (**2 Chronicles 34:24**)
- And you are righteous as regards all that **has** come upon us, for faithfully is how you **have** acted, but we are the ones that **have** done wickedly. (**Nehemiah 9:33**)
- And I will call to account **against** him and **against** his offspring and **against** his servants their error, and I will bring upon them and upon the **inhabitants of Jerusalem** and upon the men of **Judah** all the **calamity** that I **have spoken against** them, and they did not **listen**. (**Jeremiah 36:31**)
- So my rage, and my anger, was poured out and it burned in the cities of **Judah** and in the streets of **Jerusalem**, and they came to be a devastated place, a desolate waste, as at this day. (**Jeremiah 44:6**)
