- Even the architectural plan of everything that had come to be with him by inspiration for the courtyards of Yehowah's house and for all the dining rooms all around, for the treasures of the house of the true God and for the treasures of the things made holy. (1 Chronicles 28:12)
- And even Elnathan and Delaiah and Gemariah themselves pleaded with the king not to burn the roll, but he did not listen to them. (Jeremiah 36:25)
- Later Hilkiyah the High Priest said to Shaphan the secretary; The very book of the Law I have found in the house of Yehowah. So Hilkiyah gave the book to Shaphan, and he began to read it. (2 Kings 22:8)
- They even proceeded to send and take Jeremiah out of the Courtyard of the Guard and give him over to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, in order to bring him forth to his house, that he might dwell in the midst of the people. (Jeremiah 39:14)
- And seventy men of the elderly ones of the house of Israel, with Jaazaniah the son of Shaphan standing in among them, were standing before them, each one with his censer in his hand, and the perfume of the cloud of the incense was ascending. (Ezekiel 8:11)
- The said Ezra himself went up from Babylon, and he was a skilled copyist in the Law of Moses, which Yehowah the God of Israel had given, so that the king granted him, according to the hand of Yehowah his God upon him, all his request. (Ezra 7:6)
- My heart has become astir with a goodly matter. I am saying; My works are concerning a king. May my tongue be the stylus of a skilled copyist. (Psalms 45:1)

- In time the princes of Judah got to hear these **words**, and they proceeded to come up from the **house** of the king to the **house** of **Yehowah** and to sit down in the **entrance** of the **new gate** of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 26:10**)
- At that he went down to the **house** of the king, to the **dining room** of the secretary, and, look! There is where all the princes were sitting, Elishama the secretary and Delaiah the **son** of Shemaiah and Elnathan the **son** of Achbor and **Gemariah** the **son** of **Shaphan** and Zedekiah the **son** of Hananiah and all the other princes. (**Jeremiah 36:12**)
- Then they came in to the king, to the **courtyard**, and the roll they entrusted to the **dining room** of Elishama the secretary, and they **began** to tell all the **words** in the **ears** of the king. (**Jeremiah 36:20**)
