

**Jeremiah 36:12** At that he went down to the house of the king, to the dining room of the secretary, and, look! There is where all the princes were sitting, Elishama the secretary and Delaiah<sup>1</sup> the son of Shemaiah<sup>2</sup> and Elnathan the son of Achbor and Gemariah the son of Shaphan and Zedekiah the son of Hananiah<sup>3</sup> and all the other princes.

- Then they came in to the **king**, to the courtyard, and the roll they entrusted to the **dining room** of **Elishama** the **secretary**, and they began to tell all the words in the ears of the **king**. (**Jeremiah 36:20**)
- And even **Elnathan** and **Delaiah** and **Gemariah** themselves pleaded with the **king** not to burn the roll, but he did not listen to them. (**Jeremiah 36:25**)
- But King Jehoiakim sent men to Egypt, **Elnathan** the **son** of **Achbor** and other men with him to Egypt. (**Jeremiah 26:22**)
- Accordingly Hilkiah the priest and Ahikam and **Achbor** and **Shaphan** and Asaiah went to Huldah the prophetess the wife of Shallum the **son** of Tikvah the **son** of Harhas, the caretaker of the garments, as she was dwelling in Jerusalem in the second quarter, and they proceeded to speak to her. (**2 Kings 22:14**)
- And Baruch began to read aloud from the book the words of Jeremiah at the **house** of Yehowah, in the **dining room** of **Gemariah** the **son** of **Shaphan** the copyist, in the upper courtyard, at the entrance of the new gate of the **house** of Yehowah, in the ears of all the people. (**Jeremiah 36:10**)
- Later Hilkiah the High Priest said to **Shaphan** the **secretary**; The very book of the Law I have found in the **house** of Yehowah. So Hilkiah gave the book to **Shaphan**, and he began to read it. (**2 Kings 22:8**)

- Moreover, it was the hand of Ahikam the **son** of **Shaphan** that proved to be with Jeremiah, in order not to give him into the hand of the people to have him put to death. (**Jeremiah 26:24**)
- They even proceeded to send and take Jeremiah out of the Courtyard of the Guard and give him over to Gedaliah the **son** of Ahikam the **son** of **Shaphan**, in order to bring him forth to his **house**, that he might dwell in the midst of the people. (**Jeremiah 39:14**)
- So all the **princes** obeyed, and all the people who had entered into the covenant to let each one his manservant and each one his maidservant go free, in order to use them no more as servants, and they proceeded to obey and to let them go. (**Jeremiah 34:10**)
- So the **king** sent Jehudi out to get the roll. Accordingly he got it out of the **dining room** of **Elishama** the **secretary**. And Jehudi began to read it aloud in the ears of the **king** and in the ears of all the **princes** standing by the **king**. (**Jeremiah 36:21**)
- And in case the **princes** hear that I have spoken with you and they actually come in to you and say to you; Do tell us, please; What did you speak about to the **king**? Do not hide anything from us, and we shall not put you to death. And what did the **king** speak about to you? (**Jeremiah 38:25**)
