Footnote: The ninth month that is, Chislev, the postexilic name of the ninth Jewish lunar month that corresponds to the latter half of November and the first half of December See Appendix 8B

- And I will strike down the winter house in addition to the summer house. And the houses of ivory will have to perish, and many houses will have to come to their finish, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Amos 3:15**)
- So all the men of Judah and Benjamin collected themselves together at Jerusalem within three days, that is, in the ninth month on the twentieth day of the month, and all the people kept sitting in the open place of the house of the true God, shivering because of the matter and on account of the showers of rain. (**Ezra 10:9**)
- The words of Nehemiah the son of Hacaliah; Now it came about in the month Chislev, in the twentieth year, that I myself happened to be in Shushan the castle. (**Nehemiah 1:1**)
- Furthermore, it came about that in the fourth year of Darius the king the word of Yehowah occurred to Zechariah, on the fourth day of the ninth month, that is, in Chislev. (**Zechariah 7:1**)
- Now the slaves and the officers were standing about, as they had built a charcoal fire, because it was cold, and they were warming themselves. Peter also was standing with them and warming himself. (**John 18:18**)
