

**Jeremiah 36:24** And they felt no dread, neither did the king and all his servants, who were listening to all these words, rip their garments apart.

[7] - References:

- The utterance of transgression to the wicked one is in the midst of his heart, there is no **dread** of God in front of his eyes. (**Psalms 36:1**)
- And it came about that as soon as King Hezekiah heard, he immediately ripped his **garments apart** and covered himself with sackcloth and came into the house of Yehowah. (**2 Kings 19:1**)
- But Eliakim the son of Hilkiah, who was over the household, and Shebna the secretary and Joah the son of Asaph the recorder came to Hezekiah with their **garments** ripped **apart**, and told him the **words** of Rabshakeh. (**Isaiah 36:22**)
- Then the High Priest ripped his outer **garments**, saying; He has blasphemed! What further need do we have of witnesses? See! Now **you** have heard the blasphemy. (**Matthew 26:65**)
- And it came about that as soon as the **king** heard the **words** of the book of the law, he immediately ripped his **garments apart**. (**2 Kings 22:11**)
- And he continued to do what was bad in Yehowah's eyes, according to all that forefathers of his had done. (**2 Kings 23:37**)
- And down to this day they did not feel crushed, and they did not become afraid, nor did they walk in my Law and in my statutes that I put before **you** and before **your** forefathers. (**Jeremiah 44:10**)
