Jeremiah 36:31... And I will call to account against him and against his offspring and against his servants their error, and I will bring upon them and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem and upon the men<sup>1</sup> of Judah all the calamity that I have spoken against them, and they did not listen.

- I will also hold an accounting against you according to the fruitage of your dealings, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will set a fire ablaze in her forest, and it will certainly devour all the things round about her. (Jeremiah 21:14)
- Woe to the wicked one! Calamity! For the treatment rendered by his own hands will be rendered to him! (Isaiah 3:11)

- Therefore this is what Yehowah, the God of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am bringing upon Judah and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem all the calamity that I have spoken against them, for the reason that I have spoken to them but they did not listen, and I kept calling to them but they did not answer. (Jeremiah 35:17)
- But they were continually making jest at the messengers of the true God and despising his words and mocking at his prophets, until the rage of Yehowah came up against his people, until there was no healing. (2 Chronicles 36:16)

Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; As regards your wife, in the city she will become a prostitute. And as regards your sons and your daughters, by the sword they will fall. And as regards your ground, by the measuring rope it will be apportioned out. And as regards you yourself, on unclean ground you will die, and as regards Israel, it will without fail go into exile from its own ground. (Amos 7:17)
