- And I then gave the deed of purchase to **Baruch** the **son** of **Neriah** the **son** of Mahseiah before the eyes of Hanamel the **son** of my paternal uncle and before the eyes of the witnesses, those writing in the deed of purchase, before the eyes of all the Jews who were sitting in the Courtyard of the Guard. (**Jeremiah 32:12**)
- The word that **Jeremiah** the prophet spoke to **Baruch** the **son** of **Neriah** when he wrote in a **book** these **words** from the **mouth** of **Jeremiah** in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the **son** of Josiah, the king of Judah, saying; (**Jeremiah 45:1**)
- And **Baruch** the **son** of **Neriah** proceeded to do according to all that **Jeremiah** the prophet had commanded him, to read aloud from the **book** the **words** of **Yehowah** at the house of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 36:8**)
- And **Baruch** they asked, saying; Tell us, please, How did you **write** all these **words** from his mouth? (**Jeremiah 36:17**)
- But **Baruch** the **son** of **Neriah** is instigating you against us for the purpose of giving us into the hand of the Chaldeans, to put us to death or to take us into exile in Babylon. (**Jeremiah 43:3**)
- The word that **Jeremiah** the prophet commanded Seraiah the **son** of **Neriah** the **son** of Mahseiah when he went with Zedekiah the king of Judah to Babylon in the fourth year of his being king, and Seraiah was the quartermaster. (**Jeremiah 51:59**)
