

Jeremiah 36:9 Now it came about in the fifth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, the king of Judah, in the ninth month, that all the people in Jerusalem and all the people that were coming in from the cities of Judah into Jerusalem proclaimed a fast before Yehowah.

- Twenty-five **years** old was **Jehoiakim** when he began to reign, and for eleven **years** he reigned in **Jerusalem**. And his mother's name was Zebidah the daughter of Pedaiiah from Rumah. (**2 Kings 23:36**)
- The word that occurred to Jeremiah from **Yehowah** in the days of **Jehoiakim** the **son** of **Josiah**, the **king** of **Judah**, saying; (**Jeremiah 35:1**)
- The words of Nehemiah the **son** of Hacaliah; Now it came **about** in the **month** Chislev, in the twentieth **year**, that I myself happened to be in Shushan the castle. (**Nehemiah 1:1**)
- At that Jehoshaphat became afraid and set his face to search for **Yehowah**. So he **proclaimed** a **fast** for all **Judah**. (**2 Chronicles 20:3**)
- And on the twenty-fourth day of this **month** the **sons** of Israel gathered themselves together with fasting and with sackcloth and dirt upon themselves. (**Nehemiah 9:1**)
- Go, gather all the Jews that are to be found in Shushan and **fast** in my behalf and neither eat nor drink for three days, night and day. I too with my young women, I shall **fast** likewise, and upon that I shall come in to the **king**, which is not according to the law, and in case I must perish, I must perish. (**Esther 4:16**)
- Blow a horn in Zion, O men. Sanctify a time of fasting. Call together a solemn assembly. (**Joel 2:15**)
- He who observes the day observes it to **Yehowah**. Also, he who eats, eats to **Yehowah**, for he gives thanks to God, and he who does not eat does not eat to **Yehowah**, and yet gives thanks to God. (**Romans 14:6**)
