

Jeremiah 38:13• Finally they drew out Jeremiah by means of the ropes and brought him up out of the cistern. And Jeremiah continued to dwell in the Courtyard of the Guard.

- Accordingly King Zedekiah commanded, and they then put **Jeremiah** in custody in the **Courtyard** of the **Guard**, and there was a giving of a round loaf of bread to him daily from the street of the bakers, until all the bread was exhausted from the city. And **Jeremiah continued** dwelling in the **Courtyard** of the **Guard**. (**Jeremiah 37:21**)
- Now men, Midianite merchants, went passing by. Hence they **drew** and lifted up Joseph **out** of the water-pit and then sold Joseph to the Ishmaelites for twenty silver pieces. Eventually these **brought** Joseph into Egypt. (**Genesis 37:28**)
- Do bring my soul **out** of the very dungeon to laud your name. Around me let the righteous ones gather, because you deal appropriately with me. (**Psalms 142:7**)
- And they proceeded to take **Jeremiah** and throw him into the **cistern** of Malchijah the son of the king, which was in the **Courtyard** of the **Guard**. So they let **Jeremiah** down by **means** of **ropes**. Now in the **cistern** there was no water, but mire, and **Jeremiah** began to sink down into the mire. (**Jeremiah 38:6**)
