Jeremiah 38:14. And King Zedekiah proceeded to send and take Jeremiah the prophet to him to the third entryway, which is in the house of Yehowah, and then the king said to Jeremiah; I am asking something of you. Do not hide from me anything.

- The word that occurred to Jeremiah from Yehowah, when King Zedekiah sent to him Pashhur the son of Malchiah and Zephaniah the son of Maaseiah, the priest, saying; (Jeremiah 21:1)
- And the covered structure for the Sabbath that they had built in the house and the king's outer entryway he shifted from the house of Yehowah because of the king of Assyria. (2 Kings 16:18)
- Then Pashhur struck Jeremiah the prophet and put him into the stocks that were in the Upper Gate of Benjamin, which was in the house of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 20:2)
- And he went on to say; What is the word that he has spoken to you? Do not, please, hide it from me. May God do so to you and so may he add to it if you should hide from me a word of all the word that he has spoken to you. (1 Samuel 3:17)
- At that the king said to him; For how many times am I putting you under oath that you should not speak to me anything but truth in the name of Yehowah? (1 Kings 22:16)
- And he continued to do what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah his God. He did not humble himself on account of Jeremiah the prophet at the order of Yehowah. (2 Chronicles 36:12)
- And King Zedekiah proceeded to send and take him, and the king began asking him questions in his house in a place of concealment. And he went on to say; Does there exist a word from Yehowah? To this Jeremiah said; There does exist! And he said further; Into the hand of the king of Babylon you will be given! (Jeremiah 37:17)
