Jeremiah 38:19. Then King Zedekiah said to Jeremiah; I am in fright of the Jews that have fallen away to the Chaldeans, for fear that they might give me into their hand and they might actually deal abusively with me.

[3] - References:

- Trembling at men is what lays a snare, but he that is trusting in Yehowah will be protected. (Proverbs 29:25)
- Then Saul said to his armor-bearer; Draw your sword and run me through with it, that these uncircumcised men may not come and certainly run me through and deal abusively with me. And his armor-bearer was unwilling, because he was very much afraid. So Saul took the sword and fell upon it. (1 Samuel 31:4)
- A sword You have feared, and a sword I shall bring upon You, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 11:8)
