- And they proceeded to rise early in the morning and go out to the wilderness of Tekoa. And as they went out, Jehoshaphat stood up and then said; Hear me, O Judah and YOU inhabitants of Jerusalem! Put faith in Yehowah YOUR God that YOU may prove yourselves of long duration. Put faith in his prophets and so prove successful. (2 Chronicles 20:20)
- But this word I did express in command upon them, saying; Obey my voice, and I will become YOUR God, and YOU yourselves will become my people, and YOU must walk in all the way that I shall command YOU, in order that it may go well with YOU. (Jeremiah 7:23)
- And now make YOUR ways and YOUR dealings good, and obey the voice of Yehowah YOUR God, and Yehowah will feel regret for the calamity that he has spoken against YOU. (Jeremiah 26:13)
- In turn Samuel said; Does Yehowah have as much delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as in obeying the voice of Yehowah? Look! To obey is better than a sacrifice, to pay attention than the fat of rams. (1 Samuel 15:22)
- Even to Zedekiah the king of Judah I spoke according to all these words, saying; Bring YOUR necks under the yoke of the king of Babylon and serve him and his people and keep on living. (Jeremiah 27:12)
