

**Jeremiah 39:1** In the ninth year of Zedekiah the king of Judah, in the tenth month, Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon and all his military force came to Jerusalem and began to lay siege to it.

- And they will indeed besiege you within all your gates until your high and fortified walls in which you are trusting fall in all your land, yes, they will certainly besiege you within all your gates in all your land, which Yehowah your God has given you. (**Deuteronomy 28:52**)
- And it **came** about in the ninth **year** of his being **king**, in the **tenth month** on the **tenth** day of the **month**, that Nebuchadnezzar the **king of Babylon came**, yes, he and all his **military force**, against **Jerusalem** and **began** camping against it and building against it a **siege wall** all around. (**2 Kings 25:1**)
- A boar out of the woods keeps eating it away, and the animal throngs of the open field keep feeding upon it. (**Psalms 80:13**)
- And I must encamp on all sides against you, and I must **lay siege** to you with a palisade and raise up against you siegeworks. (**Isaiah 29:3**)
- Please inquire in our behalf of Yehowah, because **Nebuchadrezzar** the **king** of **Babylon** is making war against us. Perhaps Yehowah will do with us according to all his wonderful works, so that he will withdraw from us. (**Jeremiah 21:2**)
- The word that occurred to Jeremiah from Yehowah in the **tenth year** of **Zedekiah** the **king** of **Judah**, that is, the eighteenth **year** of **Nebuchadrezzar**. (**Jeremiah 32:1**)
- The word that occurred to Jeremiah from Yehowah, when **Nebuchadrezzar** the **king** of **Babylon** and all his **military force** and all the kingdoms of the earth, the dominion under his hand, and all the peoples were fighting against **Jerusalem** and against all her cities, saying; (**Jeremiah 34:1**)
- Here I am commanding, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I shall certainly bring them back to this city, and they must fight against it and capture it and burn it with fire, and the cities of **Judah** I shall make a desolate waste without an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 34:22**)

- Finally it **came** about in the ninth **year** of his being **king**, in the **tenth month**, on the **tenth** day of the **month**, that **Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon came**, he and all his **military force**, against **Jerusalem**, and they **began** to camp against her and to build against her a **siege** wall all around. (**Jeremiah 52:4**)
- And you must **lay siege** against it and build a **siege** wall against it and throw up a **siege** rampart against it and set encampments against it and put battering rams all around against it. (**Ezekiel 4:2**)
- Son of man, write down for yourself the name of the day, this selfsame day. The **king of Babylon** has thrown himself against **Jerusalem** on this selfsame day. (**Ezekiel 24:2**)
- And the word of Yehowah continued to occur to me in the ninth **year**, in the **tenth month**, on the **tenth** day of the **month**, saying; (**Ezekiel 24:1**)
- And the city **came** to be under **siege** until the eleventh **year** of King **Zedekiah**. (**2 Kings 25:2**)
- Finally it **came** about in the ninth **year** of his being **king**, in the **tenth month**, on the **tenth** day of the **month**, that **Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon came**, he and all his **military force**, against **Jerusalem**, and they **began** to camp against her and to build against her a **siege** wall all around. (**Jeremiah 52:4**)
