

**Jeremiah 39:14** They even proceeded to send and take Jeremiah out of the Courtyard of the Guard and give him over to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, in order to bring him forth to his house, that he might dwell in the midst of the people.

[16] - References:

- And **Jeremiah** continued to **dwell** in the **Courtyard** of the **Guard** until the day that Jerusalem was captured. And it occurred just when Jerusalem was captured. (**Jeremiah 38:28**)
- As for the **people** left behind in the land of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had left behind, he now appointed over them **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of **Shaphan**. (**2 Kings 25:22**)
- And he was yet not one that would return, when Nebuzaradan said; Do return to **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of **Shaphan**, whom the king of Babylon has commissioned over the cities of Judah, and **dwell** with him in the **midst** of the **people**, or to wherever it is right in your eyes to go, go. And the chief of the bodyguard then gave him a food allowance and a present and let him go. (**Jeremiah 40:5**)
- Then Ishmael the **son** of Nethaniah and the ten men that happened to be with him rose up and struck down **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of **Shaphan** with the sword. So he put to death the one whom the king of Babylon had commissioned over the land. (**Jeremiah 41:2**)
- Then the king commanded Hilkiyah and **Ahikam** the **son** of **Shaphan** and Abdon the **son** of Micah and **Shaphan** the secretary and Asaiah the king's servant, saying; (**2 Chronicles 34:20**)
- Moreover, it was the hand of **Ahikam** the **son** of **Shaphan** that proved to be with **Jeremiah**, in **order** not to **give** him into the hand of the **people** to have him put to death. (**Jeremiah 26:24**)
- Later Hilkiyah the High Priest said to **Shaphan** the secretary; The very book of the Law I have found in the **house** of Yehowah. So Hilkiyah gave the book to **Shaphan**, and he began to read it. (**2 Kings 22:8**)
- It was by the hand of Elasah the **son** of **Shaphan** and Gemariah the **son** of Hilkiyah, whom Zedekiah the king of Judah sent to

Babylon to Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, saying;  
(**Jeremiah 29:3**)

- And Baruch began to read aloud from the book the words of **Jeremiah** at the **house** of Yehowah, in the dining room of Gemariah the **son** of **Shaphan** the copyist, in the upper courtyard, at the entrance of the new gate of the **house** of Yehowah, in the ears of all the **people**. (**Jeremiah 36:10**)
- At that he went down to the **house** of the king, to the dining room of the secretary, and, look! There is where all the princes were sitting, Elishama the secretary and Delaiah the **son** of Shemaiah and Elnathan the **son** of Achbor and Gemariah the **son** of **Shaphan** and Zedekiah the **son** of Hananiah and all the other princes. (**Jeremiah 36:12**)
- The word that occurred to **Jeremiah** from Yehowah after Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard sent him from Ramah, when he took him while he was bound with handcuffs in the **midst** of all the exiles of Jerusalem and of Judah, who were being taken into exile in Babylon. (**Jeremiah 40:1**)
- Accordingly **Jeremiah** came to **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** at Mizpah and took up dwelling with him in the **midst** of the **people** who were left remaining in the land. (**Jeremiah 40:6**)
- And **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of **Shaphan** proceeded to swear to them and to their men, saying; Do not be afraid of serving the Chaldeans. Continue dwelling in the land and serve the king of Babylon, and it will go well with **you**. (**Jeremiah 40:9**)
- And all the Jews that were in Moab and among the **sons** of Ammon and in Edom and those who were in all the other lands, they also heard that the king of Babylon had given a remnant to Judah and that he had commissioned over them **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of **Shaphan**. (**Jeremiah 40:11**)
- And Johanan the **son** of Kareah himself said to **Gedaliah**, in a place of concealment in Mizpah; I want to go, now, and strike down Ishmael the **son** of Nethaniah, as no one at all will know. Why should he strike you to the soul, and why must all those of Judah who are being collected together to you be scattered and the remnant of Judah perish? (**Jeremiah 40:15**)

- But **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** said to Johanan the **son** of Kareah; Do not do this thing, for it is a falsehood that you are speaking concerning Ishmael. (**Jeremiah 40:16**)
