Jeremiah 39:16... Go, and you must say to Ebed-melech the Ethiopian, This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am bringing true my words upon this city for calamity and not for good, and they will certainly happen before you in that day.

- And Ebed-melech the Ethiopian, a man who was a eunuch and who was in the house of the king, got to hear that they had put Jeremiah into the cistern, and the king was sitting in the Gate of Benjamin. (Jeremiah 38:7)
