Jeremiah 39:18... For I shall without fail furnish you an escape, and by the sword you will not fall, and you will certainly come to have your soul as a spoil, because you have trusted in me, is the utterance of Yehowah.

- The one sitting still in this city will die by the sword and by the famine and by the pestilence, but the one who is going out and who actually falls away to the Chaldeans who are laying siege against YOU will keep living, and his soul will certainly come to be his as a spoil. (Jeremiah 21:9)
- But as for you, you keep seeking great things for yourself. Do not keep on seeking. For here I am bringing in a calamity upon all flesh, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will give you your soul as a spoil in all the places to which you may go. (Jeremiah 45:5)
- And they came to be helped against them, so that the Hagrites and all those who were with them were given into their hand, for it was to God that they called for aid in the war, and he let himself be entreated in their favor because they trusted in him. (1 Chronicles 5:20)
- Trust in Yehowah and do good; Reside in the earth, and deal with faithfulness. (Psalms 37:3)
- And Yehowah will help them and provide them with escape. He will provide them with escape from wicked people and save them, because they have taken refuge in him. (Psalms 37:40)
- O Yehowah of armies, happy is the man that is trusting in you. (Psalms 84:12)
- Blessed is the able-bodied man who puts his trust in Yehowah, and whose confidence Yehowah has become. (Jeremiah 17:7)
- After that the king of Sodom said to Abram; Give me the souls, but take the goods for yourself. (Genesis 14:21)
- And he proceeded to do so to them and to deliver them from the hand of the sons of Israel, and they did not kill them. (Joshua 9:26)

- The righteousness of the upright ones is what will deliver them, but by their craving those dealing treacherously will themselves be caught. (Proverbs 11:6)
