Jeremiah 39:3" And all the princes of the king of Babylon proceeded to come in and sit down in the Middle Gate, namely, Nergalsharezer, Samgar-nebo, Sarsechim, Rabsaris, Nergal-sharezer the Rabmag<sup>2</sup> and all the rest of the princes of the king of Babylon.
