Jeremiah 39:4" Now it came about that as soon as Zedekiah the king of Judah and all the men of war saw them, they began to run away and to go out by night from the city by the way of the garden of the king, by the gate between the double wall, and they kept going out by the way of the Arabah.¹

- Yehowah will cause you to be defeated before your enemies. By one way you will go out against them, but by seven ways you will flee before them, and you must become a frightful object to all the earth's kingdoms. (Deuteronomy 28:25)
- And the city got to be breached, and all the men of war fled by night by the way of the gate between the double wall that is by the king's garden, while the Chaldeans were all around against the city, and the king began to go in the direction of the Arabah. (2 Kings 25:4)
- Turn and set out on YOUR way and go into the mountainous region of the Amorites and to all their neighbors in the Arabah, the mountainous region and the Shephelah and the Negeb and the seacoast, the land of the Canaanites, and Lebanon, up to the great river, the river Euphrates. (Deuteronomy 1:7)
- Furthermore, he took courage and built up all the broken-down wall and raised towers upon it, and on the outside another wall, and repaired the Mound of the City of David, and made missiles in abundance and shields. (2 Chronicles 32:5)
- And the Fountain Gate was what Shallun the son of Colhozeh, a prince of the district of Mizpah, repaired, he himself proceeded to build it and to roof it over and to set up its doors, its bolts and its bars, and also the wall of the Pool of the Canal to the King's Garden and as far as the Stairway that goes down from the City of David. (Nehemiah 3:15)
- I made gardens and parks for myself, and I planted in them fruit trees of all sorts. (Ecclesiastes 2:5)
- All your dictators themselves have fled at one time. Without need of a bow they have been taken prisoner. All those of you

- who have been found have been taken prisoner together. Far off they had run away. (Isaiah 22:3)
- Finally the city was broken through, and as regards all the men of war, they began to run away and go forth from the city by night by the way of the gate between the double wall that is by the king's garden, while the Chaldeans were all around against the city, and they kept going by the way of the Arabah. (Jeremiah 52:7)
- They have hunted our steps so that there is no walking in our public squares. Our end has drawn near. Our days have come to their full, for our end has come. (Lamentations 4:18)
- Before their eyes, bore your way through the wall, and you must do the bringing out through it. (Ezekiel 12:5)
- And as regards the chieftain who is in the midst of them, on the shoulder he will do carrying in the darkness and go out, through the wall they will bore in order to do the bringing forth through it. His face he will cover in order that he may not see with his own eye the earth. (Ezekiel 12:12)
