

Jeremiah 39:5 And a military force of the Chaldeans went chasing after them, and they got to overtake Zedekiah in the desert plains of Jericho. Then they took him and brought him up to Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon at Riblah in the land of Hamath that he might pronounce upon him judicial decisions.

- And **Zedekiah** himself, the **king** of Judah, will not escape from the hand of the **Chaldeans**, for he will without fail be given into the hand of the **king** of **Babylon**, and his mouth will actually speak with the mouth of that one, and his own eyes will see even the eyes of that one. (**Jeremiah 32:4**)
- But if you will not go out to the princes of the **king** of **Babylon**, this city must also be given into the hand of the **Chaldeans**, and they will actually burn it with fire, and you yourself will not escape out of their hand. (**Jeremiah 38:18**)
- And the sons of Israel continued to camp in Gilgal, and they proceeded to carry out the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month, in the evening, on the **desert plains** of **Jericho**. (**Joshua 5:10**)
- And a military **force** of the **Chaldeans** went chasing after the **king**, and they **got** to **overtake Zedekiah** in the **desert plains** of **Jericho**, and all his own military **force** was scattered from his side. (**Jeremiah 52:8**)
- And Pharaoh Nechoh **got** to put him in bonds at **Riblah** in the **land** of **Hamath**, to keep him from reigning in Jerusalem, and then imposed a fine upon the **land** of a hundred silver talents and a gold talent. (**2 Kings 23:33**)
- Then they seized the **king** and **brought** him up to the **king** of **Babylon** at **Riblah**, that they **might pronounce** a **judicial** decision upon him. (**2 Kings 25:6**)
- And the **king** of **Babylon** proceeded to strike them down and put them to death at **Riblah** in the **land** of **Hamath**. Thus Judah **went** into exile from off its soil. (**2 Kings 25:21**)
- So these Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard **took** and conducted them to the **king** of **Babylon** at **Riblah**. (**Jeremiah 52:26**)

- And the **land** of the Gebalites and all of Lebanon toward the rising of the sun, from Baal-gad at the base of Mount Hermon as far as to the entering in of **Hamath**. (**Joshua 13:5**)
- The five axis lords of the Philistines, and all the Canaanites, even the Sidonians and the Hivites inhabiting Mount Lebanon from Mount Baal-hermon as far as to the entering in of **Hamath**. (**Judges 3:3**)
- Subsequently the **king** of Assyria **brought** people from **Babylon** and Cuthah and Avva and **Hamath** and Sepharvaim and had them dwell in the cities of Samaria instead of the sons of Israel, and they began to take possession of Samaria and to dwell in its cities. (**2 Kings 17:24**)
- Then they seized the **king** and **brought** him up to the **king** of **Babylon** at **Riblah** in the **land** of **Hamath**, that he **might pronounce** upon him **judicial decisions**. (**Jeremiah 52:9**)
- And a military **force** of **Chaldeans** went chasing after the **king**, and they **got** to **overtake** him in the **desert plains** of **Jericho**, and all his own military **force** was scattered from his side. (**2 Kings 25:5**)
- And Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard then **took** them and conducted them to the **king** of **Babylon** at **Riblah**. (**2 Kings 25:20**)
- And **after** that, is the utterance of Yehowah, I shall give **Zedekiah** the **king** of Judah and his servants and the people and those who are remaining over in this city from the pestilence, from the sword and from the famine, into the hand of **Nebuchadrezzar** the **king** of **Babylon**, even into the hand of their enemies and into the hand of those who are seeking for their soul, and he will certainly strike them with the edge of the sword. He will not feel sorry for them, nor will he show compassion or have any mercy. (**Jeremiah 21:7**)
- And you yourself will not escape out of his hand, because you will without fail be caught and into his hand you will be given. And your own eyes will see even the eyes of the **king** of **Babylon**, and his own mouth will speak even with your mouth, and to **Babylon** you will come. (**Jeremiah 34:3**)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Here I am giving Pharaoh Hophra, the **king** of Egypt, into the hand of his enemies and into the hand of those seeking for his soul, just as I have given

Zedekiah the king of Judah into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, his enemy and the one seeking for his soul. (Jeremiah 44:30)

- **The very breath of our nostrils, the anointed one of Yehowah, has been captured in their large pit, the one of whom we have said; In his shade we shall live among the nations. (Lamentations 4:20)**
- **And they must come in against you with rattling of war chariots and wheels, and with a congregation of peoples, with large shield and buckler and helmet. They will set themselves against you all around, and I will give judgment over to them, and they must judge you with their judgments. (Ezekiel 23:24)**
