

Jeremiah 39:6 And the king of Babylon proceeded to slaughter the sons of Zedekiah in Riblah before his eyes, and all the nobles of Judah the king of Babylon slaughtered.

- And Zedekiah's sons they slaughtered before his eyes, and Zedekiah's eyes he blinded, after which he bound him with copper fetters and brought him to Babylon. (2 Kings 25:7)
- And the king of Babylon proceeded to slaughter the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes, and also all the princes of Judah he slaughtered in Riblah. (Jeremiah 52:10)
- And you will certainly become maddened at the sight of your eyes that you will see. (Deuteronomy 28:34)
- And their very children will be dashed to pieces before their eyes. Their houses will be pillaged, and their own wives will be raped. (Isaiah 13:16)
- And after that, is the utterance of Yehowah, I shall give Zedekiah the king of Judah and his servants and the people and those who are remaining over in this city from the pestilence, from the sword and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, even into the hand of their enemies and into the hand of those who are seeking for their soul, and he will certainly strike them with the edge of the sword. He will not feel sorry for them, nor will he show compassion or have any mercy. (Jeremiah 21:7)
- Namely, the princes of Judah and the princes of Jerusalem, the court officials and the priests and all the people of the land who went passing between the pieces of the calf. (Jeremiah 34:19)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; Here I am making you a fright to yourself and to all your lovers, and they will certainly fall by the sword of their enemies while your eyes will be looking on, and all Judah I shall give into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he will actually take them into exile in Babylon and strike them down with the sword. (Jeremiah 20:4)
- And Zedekiah the king of Judah and his princes I shall give into the hand of their enemies and into the hand of those seeking for their soul and into the hand of the military forces of the king of

Babylon who are withdrawing from against **you** men. (**Jeremiah 34:21**)

- And all your wives and your **sons** they are bringing out to the Chaldeans, and you yourself will not escape out of their hand, but by the hand of the **king** of **Babylon** you will be seized, and because of you this city will be burned with fire. (**Jeremiah 38:23**)
- Princes themselves have been hanged by just their hand. The faces of even old men have not been honored. (**Lamentations 5:12**)
- And I shall certainly bring **you** forth out of the midst of her and give **you** into the hand of strangers and execute upon **you** acts of judgment. (**Ezekiel 11:9**)
- For an extermination has been made, and what of it if it is rejecting also the scepter? This will not continue existing, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 21:13**)
- Let there be a taking of the choicest sheep, and also stack the logs in a circle under it. Boil its pieces, also cook its bones in the midst of it. (**Ezekiel 24:5**)
- And it must occur on the day of Yehowah's sacrifice that I will give attention to the princes, and to the **sons** of the **king**, and to all those wearing foreign attire. (**Zephaniah 1:8**)
