

Jeremiah 39:8 And the house of the king and the houses of the people the Chaldeans burned with fire, and the walls of Jerusalem they pulled down.

[21] - References:

- And he proceeded to burn the house of Yehowah and the king's house and all the houses of Jerusalem, and the house of every great man he burned with fire. (2 Kings 25:9)
- And he proceeded to burn the house of the true God and pull down the wall of Jerusalem, and all its dwelling towers they burned with fire and also all its desirable articles, so as to cause ruin. (2 Chronicles 36:19)
- In my ears Yehowah of armies has sworn that many houses, though great and good, will become an outright object of astonishment, without an inhabitant. (Isaiah 5:9)
- But if you will not go out to the princes of the king of Babylon, this city must also be given into the hand of the Chaldeans, and they will actually burn it with fire, and you yourself will not escape out of their hand. (Jeremiah 38:18)
- And the walls of Jerusalem, all around, the entire military force of Chaldeans that were with the chief of the bodyguard pulled down. (2 Kings 25:10)
- Accordingly they said to me; Those left over, who have been left over from the captivity, there in the jurisdictional district, are in a very bad plight and in reproach, and the wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its very gates have been burned with fire. (Nehemiah 1:3)
- And all the walls of Jerusalem, round about, all the military forces of the Chaldeans that were with the chief of the bodyguard pulled down. (Jeremiah 52:14)
- Come up against her vine rows and cause ruin, but do not you men make an actual extermination. Take away her luxuriating shoots, for they do not belong to Yehowah. (Jeremiah 5:10)
- But if you will not obey me by sanctifying the Sabbath day and not carrying a load, but there is a coming in with it through the gates of Jerusalem on the Sabbath day, I will also set a fire

ablaze in her gates, and it will certainly devour the dwelling towers of **Jerusalem** and will not be extinguished. (**Jeremiah 17:27**)

- For I have set my face against this city for calamity and not for good, is the utterance of Yehowah. Into the hand of the **king** of Babylon it will be given, and he will certainly burn it with fire. (**Jeremiah 21:10**)
- But if **you** will not obey these words, by myself I do swear, is the utterance of Yehowah, that this house will become a mere devastated place. (**Jeremiah 22:5**)
- This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; Go, and you must say to Zedekiah the **king** of Judah, yes, you must say to him; This is what Yehowah has said, Here I am giving this city into the hand of the **king** of Babylon, and he must burn it with **fire**. (**Jeremiah 34:2**)
- Here I am commanding, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I shall certainly bring them back to this city, and they must fight against it and capture it and burn it with **fire**, and the cities of Judah I shall make a desolate waste without an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 34:22**)
- And the **Chaldeans** will certainly come back and fight against this city and capture it and burn it with **fire**. (**Jeremiah 37:8**)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said, Just as my anger and my rage have been poured out upon the inhabitants of **Jerusalem**, so my rage will be poured out upon **you** because of **your** entering into Egypt, and **you** will certainly become a curse and an object of astonishment and a malediction and a reproach, and you will no more see this place. (**Jeremiah 42:18**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; **You** yourselves have seen all the calamity that I have brought in upon **Jerusalem** and upon all the cities of Judah, and here they are a devastated place this day, and in them there is no inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 44:2**)
- So my rage, and my anger, was poured out and it **burned** in the cities of Judah and in the streets of **Jerusalem**, and they came to be a devastated place, a desolate waste, as at this day. (**Jeremiah 44:6**)

- **Yehowah has thought of bringing the wall of the daughter of Zion to ruin. He has stretched out the measuring line. He has not turned back his hand from swallowing up. And he causes rampart and wall to go mourning. Together they have faded away. ([Lamentations 2:8](#))**
- **And they must burn your [houses](#) with [fire](#) and execute in you acts of judgment before the eyes of many women, and I will cause you to cease from being a prostitute, and also no more hire will you give. ([Ezekiel 16:41](#))**
- **And the congregation must pelt them with stones, and there will be a cutting of them [down](#) with their swords. Their sons and their daughters they will kill, and with [fire](#) their [houses](#) they will burn. ([Ezekiel 23:47](#))**
- **And he proceeded to carry out his words that he had spoken against us and against our judges who judged us, by bringing upon us great calamity, such as was not done under the whole heavens as what has been done in [Jerusalem](#). ([Daniel 9:12](#))**
