

**Jeremiah 3:10\*\* And even for all this her treacherous sister Judah did not return to me with all her heart, only falsely, is the utterance of Yehowah.**

[6] - References:

- And their **heart** was not steadfast with him, and they did not prove faithful in his covenant. (**Psalms 78:37**)
- And they did not call to me for aid with their **heart**, although they kept howling on their beds. On account of their grain and sweet wine they kept loafing about, they kept turning against me. (**Hosea 7:14**)
- Those crooked at **heart** are something detestable to Yehowah, but the ones blameless in their way are a pleasure to him. (**Proverbs 11:20**)
- And Yehowah says; For the reason that this people have come near with their mouth, and they have glorified me merely with their lips, and they have removed their **heart** itself far away from me, and their fear toward me becomes men's commandment that is being taught. (**Isaiah 29:13**)
- Although you are committing fornication, O Israel, let not **Judah** become guilty, and do not **you** people come to Gilgal, neither go up to Beth-aven nor swear; As Yehowah is alive! (**Hosea 4:15**)
