Jeremiah 3:2. Raise your eyes to the beaten paths and see. Where is it that you have not been raped? Alongside the ways you have sat for them, like an Arabian in the wilderness, and you keep polluting the land with your acts of prostitution and with your badness.

- That you went building for yourself a mound and making for yourself a height in every public square. (Ezekiel 16:24)
- And she went on uncovering her acts of prostitution and uncovering her nakedness, so that my soul turned away disgusted from company with her, just as my soul had turned away disgusted from company with her sister. (Ezekiel 23:18)
