Jeremiah 40:12. And all the Jews began to return from all the places to which they had been dispersed, and they kept coming into the land of Judah to Gedaliah at Mizpah. And they went gathering wine and summer fruits in very great quantity.

- Consequently all the sons of Israel went out and the assembly congregated themselves as one man, from Dan down to Beersheba along with the land of Gilead, to Yehowah at Mizpah. (Judges 20:1)
- Then Samuel said; Collect all Israel together at Mizpah, that I may pray in Your behalf to Yehowah. (1 Samuel 7:5)
- And King Asa, for his part, summoned all Judah, there was none exempt, and they proceeded to carry the stones of Ramah and the timbers of it, with which Baasha had been building, and King Asa began to build with them Geba in Benjamin, and Mizpah. (1 Kings 15:22)
- Then Ishmael took captive all the remnant of the people who were in Mizpah, the daughters of the king and all the people who were remaining over in Mizpah, whom Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard had put in the custody of Gedaliah the son of Ahikam. So Ishmael the son of Nethaniah took them captive and went off to cross over to the sons of Ammon. (Jeremiah 41:10)
