Jeremiah 40:4" And now, look! I have let you loose today from the handcuffs that were upon your hands. If it is good in your eyes to come with me to Babylon, come, and I shall keep my eye upon you. But if it is bad in your eyes to come with me to Babylon, refrain. See! The entire land is before you. To wherever it is good and right in your eyes to go, go there.

- Take him and keep your own eyes set upon him, and do not do to him anything bad at all. But just as he may speak to you, so do with him. (Jeremiah 39:12)
- Further Abimelech said; Here my land is available to you. Dwell where it is good in your eyes. (Genesis 20:15)
