

Jeremiah 40:6 Accordingly Jeremiah came to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam at Mizpah and took up dwelling with him in the midst of the people who were left remaining in the land.

- They even proceeded to send and take Jeremiah out of the Courtyard of the Guard and give him over to **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of Shaphan, in order to bring him forth to his house, that he might dwell in the **midst** of the **people**. (**Jeremiah 39:14**)
- Consequently all the **sons** of Israel went out and the assembly congregated themselves as one man, from Dan down to Beer-sheba along with the **land** of Gilead, to Yehowah at **Mizpah**. (**Judges 20:1**)
- And King Asa, for his part, summoned all Judah, there was none exempt, and they proceeded to carry the stones of Ramah and the timbers of it, with which Baasha had been building, and King Asa began to build with them Geba in Benjamin, and **Mizpah**. (**1 Kings 15:22**)
- Now the men of Israel had sworn in **Mizpah**, saying; Not a man of us will give his daughter to Benjamin as a wife. (**Judges 21:1**)
- Then Samuel said; Collect all Israel together at **Mizpah**, that I may pray in **YOUR** behalf to Yehowah. (**1 Samuel 7:5**)
- As for the **people left** behind in the **land** of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had **left** behind, he now appointed over them **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of Shaphan. (**2 Kings 25:22**)
- As for Asa the king, he **took** all Judah, and they proceeded to carry away the stones of Ramah and its timbers with which Baasha had built, and he began to build with them Geba and **Mizpah**. (**2 Chronicles 16:6**)
- And at their side Melatiah the Gibeonite and Jadon the Meronothite, did repair work, men of Gibeon and **Mizpah**, belonging to the throne of the governor beyond the River. (**Nehemiah 3:7**)

- And the Fountain Gate was what Shallun the **son** of Colhozeh, a prince of the district of **Mizpah**, repaired, he himself proceeded to build it and to roof it over and to set up its doors, its bolts and its bars, and also the wall of the Pool of the Canal to the King's Garden and as far as the Stairway that goes down from the City of David. (**Nehemiah 3:15**)
- And as for me, here I am **dwelling** in **Mizpah**, in order to stand before the Chaldeans who will come to us. And as for **you** yourselves, gather wine and summer fruits and oil and put them in **YOUR** vessels and dwell in **YOUR** cities that **YOU** have seized. (**Jeremiah 40:10**)
- So it **came** about in the seventh month that Ishmael the **son** of Nethaniah the **son** of Elishama of the royal offspring and of the principal men of the king and ten other men with him **came** to **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** at **Mizpah**. And there they began to eat bread together in **Mizpah**. (**Jeremiah 41:1**)
- And all the **people** whom Ishmael had led captive from **Mizpah** proceeded to turn around and return and go to Johanan the **son** of Kareah. (**Jeremiah 41:14**)
- And you must take therefrom a few in number and wrap them up in your skirts. (**Ezekiel 5:3**)
