

Jeremiah 40:7 In time all the chiefs¹ of the military forces who were in the field, they and their men, got to hear that the king of Babylon had commissioned Gedaliah the son of Ahikam over the land and that he had commissioned him over the men and women and little children and some of the lowly people of the land, who had not been taken into exile in Babylon.

- When all the chiefs of the **military forces**, they and their **men**, heard that the **king of Babylon** had appointed **Gedaliah**, they immediately came to **Gedaliah** at Mizpah, that is, Ishmael the **son** of Nethaniah and Johanan the **son** of Kareah and Seraiah the **son** of Tanhumeth the Netophathite and Jaazaniah the **son** of the Maacathite, they and their **men**. (**2 Kings 25:23**)
- As for the **people** left behind in the **land** of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar the **king of Babylon** had left behind, he now appointed over them **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of Shaphan. (**2 Kings 25:22**)
- And some of the **people**, the **lowly** ones who had nothing at all, Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard let remain in the **land** of Judah, and he went on to give them vineyards and compulsory services on that day. (**Jeremiah 39:10**)
- An some of the **lowly** ones of the **land** Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard let remain as vinedressers and as compulsory laborers. (**Jeremiah 52:16**)
- And some of the **lowly people** of the **land** the chief of the bodyguard let remain as vinedressers and compulsory laborers. (**2 Kings 25:12**)
- As for Johanan the **son** of Kareah and all the chiefs of the **military forces** who were in the **field**, they came to **Gedaliah** at Mizpah. (**Jeremiah 40:13**)
- Then Ishmael the **son** of Nethaniah and the ten **men** that happened to be with him rose up and struck down **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of Shaphan with the sword. So he put to death the one whom the **king of Babylon** had **commissioned** over the **land**. (**Jeremiah 41:2**)

- Then Ishmael took captive all the remnant of the **people** who were in Mizpah, the daughters of the **king** and all the **people** who were remaining over in Mizpah, whom Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard had put in the custody of **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam**. So Ishmael the **son** of Nethaniah took them captive and went off to cross over to the **sons** of Ammon. (**Jeremiah 41:10**)
- Even the able-bodied **men** and the wives and the **little children** and the daughters of the **king** and every soul that Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard had let stay with **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet and Baruch the **son** of Neriah. (**Jeremiah 43:6**)
