

Jeremiah 40:8 So they came to Gedaliah at Mizpah, even Ishmael the son of Nethaniah¹ and Johanan and Jonathan, the sons of Kareah, and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth and the sons of Ephai the Netophathite and Jezaniah² the son of the Maacathite, they and their men.

- And it came about in the seventh month that **Ishmael** the **son** of **Nethaniah** the **son** of Elishama of the royal offspring came, and also ten **men** with him, and they got to strike down **Gedaliah**, so that he died, and also the Jews and the Chaldeans that happened to be with him in **Mizpah**. (**2 Kings 25:25**)
- So it came about in the seventh month that **Ishmael** the **son** of **Nethaniah** the **son** of Elishama of the royal offspring and of the principal **men** of the king and ten other **men** with him came to **Gedaliah** the **son** of Ahikam at **Mizpah**. And there they began to eat bread together in **Mizpah**. (**Jeremiah 41:1**)
- In time **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** and all the chiefs of the military forces who were with him got to hear all the bad that **Ishmael** the **son** of **Nethaniah** had done. (**Jeremiah 41:11**)
- **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** and all the chiefs of the military forces who were with him now took all the remnant of the people whom they brought back from **Ishmael** the **son** of **Nethaniah**, from **Mizpah**, after he had struck down **Gedaliah** the **son** of Ahikam, able-bodied **men**, **men** of war, and the wives and the little children and the court officials, whom he brought back from Gibeon. (**Jeremiah 41:16**)
- Then all the chiefs of the military forces and **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** and **Jezaniah** the **son** of Hoshai and all the people, from the smallest one **even** to the greatest one, approached. (**Jeremiah 42:1**)
- Zalmon the Ahohite, Maharai the **Netophathite**. (**2 Samuel 23:28**)

- The **sons** of Salma were Bethlehem and the **Netophathites**, Atroth-beth-joab and half of the Manahathites, the Zorites. (**1 Chronicles 2:54**)
- Maharai the **Netophathite**, Heled the **son** of Baanah the **Netophathite**. (**1 Chronicles 11:30**)
- When all the chiefs of the military forces, they and their **men**, heard that the king of Babylon had appointed **Gedaliah**, they immediately came to **Gedaliah** at **Mizpah**, that is, **Ishmael** the **son** of **Nethaniah** and **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** and **Seraiah** the **son** of **Tanhumeth** the **Netophathite** and Jaazaniah the **son** of the **Maacathite**, they and their **men**. (**2 Kings 25:23**)
- Then all the chiefs of the military forces and **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** and **Jezaniah** the **son** of Hoshai and all the people, from the smallest one **even** to the greatest one, approached. (**Jeremiah 42:1**)
- And who ruled in Mount Hermon and in Salecah and in all Bashan, as far as the boundary of the Geshurites and the **Maacathites**, and half of Gilead, to the territory of Sihon the king of Heshbon. (**Joshua 12:5**)
- And all the Jews who happened to be with him, that is, with **Gedaliah**, in **Mizpah**, and the Chaldeans who were found there, that is, the **men** of war, **Ishmael** struck down. (**Jeremiah 41:3**)
- The **men** of Bethlehem and Netophah, a hundred and eighty-eight. (**Nehemiah 7:26**)
- As for **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** and all the chiefs of the military forces who were in the field, they came to **Gedaliah** at **Mizpah**. (**Jeremiah 40:13**)
- And they proceeded to say to him; Do you not at all know that Baalis, the king of the **sons** of Ammon, himself has sent **Ishmael** the **son** of **Nethaniah** to strike you to the soul? But **Gedaliah** the **son** of Ahikam did not believe them. (**Jeremiah 40:14**)
- Now the cistern into which **Ishmael** threw all the carcasses of the **men** that he had struck down was a great cistern, the one that King Asa had made because of Baasha the king of Israel. It was the one that **Ishmael** the **son** of **Nethaniah** filled with those slain. (**Jeremiah 41:9**)
