

**Jeremiah 41:1** So it came about in the seventh month that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah the son of Elishama of the royal offspring<sup>1</sup> and of the principal men of the king and ten other men with him came to Gedaliah<sup>2</sup> the son of Ahikam at Mizpah. And there they began to eat bread together in Mizpah.

- When all the chiefs of the military forces, they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had appointed Gedaliah, they immediately came to Gedaliah at Mizpah, that is, Ishmael the son of Nethaniah and Johanan the son of Kareah and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth the Netophathite and Jaazaniah the son of the Maacathite, they and their men. (2 Kings 25:23)
- And they proceeded to say to him; Do you not at all know that Baalis, the king of the sons of Ammon, himself has sent Ishmael the son of Nethaniah to strike you to the soul? But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam did not believe them. (Jeremiah 40:14)
- And it came about in the seventh month that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah the son of Elishama of the royal offspring came, and also ten men with him, and they got to strike down Gedaliah, so that he died, and also the Jews and the Chaldeans that happened to be with him in Mizpah. (2 Kings 25:25)
- Furthermore, he took one of the royal seed and concluded a covenant with him and brought him into an oath, and the foremost men of the land he took away. (Ezekiel 17:13)
- Accordingly Jeremiah came to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam at Mizpah and took up dwelling with him in the midst of the people who were left remaining in the land. (Jeremiah 40:6)
- Also the man at peace with me, in whom I trusted, who was eating my bread, has magnified his heel against me. (Psalms 41:9)
- So they came to Gedaliah at Mizpah, even Ishmael the son of Nethaniah and Johanan and Jonathan, the sons of Kareah, and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth and the sons of Ephai the

Netophathite and Jezaniah the **son** of the Maacathite, they and their **men**. (**Jeremiah 40:8**)

- Say to all the people of the land and to the priests; When **you** fasted and there was a wailing in the fifth **month** and in the **seventh month**, and this for seventy years, did **you** really fast to me, even me? (**Zechariah 7:5**)
