

Jeremiah 43:11 **And he must come in and strike the land of Egypt. Whoever is due for deadly plague will be for deadly plague, and whoever is due for captivity will be for captivity, and whoever is due for the sword will be for the sword.**

[14] - References:

- Pharaoh the king of **Egypt** and his servants and his princes and all his people. (**Jeremiah 25:19**)
- For **Egypt**, concerning the military force of Pharaoh Necho the king of **Egypt**, who happened to be by the river Euphrates at Carchemish, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon defeated in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, the king of Judah. (**Jeremiah 46:2**)
- The word that Yehowah spoke to Jeremiah the prophet as regards the coming of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon to **strike** down the **land** of **Egypt**. (**Jeremiah 46:13**)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am giving to Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon the **land** of **Egypt**, and he must carry off its wealth and make a big spoil of it and do a great deal of plundering of it, and it must become wages for his military force. (**Ezekiel 29:19**)
- And a **sword will** certainly **come** into **Egypt**, and severe pains must occur in Ethiopia when one falls slain in **Egypt** and they actually take its wealth and its foundations are actually torn down. (**Ezekiel 30:4**)
- And in Tehaphnehes the day **will** actually grow dark, when I break there the yoke bars of **Egypt**. And in her the pride of her strength **will** actually be made to cease. As for her, clouds themselves **will** cover her, and into **captivity** her own dependent towns **will** go. (**Ezekiel 30:18**)
- And it must occur that should they say to you; Where shall we go out to? You must also say to them; This is what Yehowah has said; Whoever is for **deadly plague**, to **deadly plague**! And whoever is for the **sword**, to the **sword**! And whoever is for the famine, to the famine! And whoever is for the **captivity**, to the captivity! (**Jeremiah 15:2**)

- And I **will** hold an accounting against those dwelling in the **land of Egypt**, just as I held an accounting against Jerusalem, with the **sword**, with the famine and with the pestilence. (**Jeremiah 44:13**)
- A third of you, by the pestilence they **will** die, and by famine they **will come** to their end in the midst of you. And another third, by the **sword** they **will** fall all around you. And the last third I shall scatter even to every wind, and a **sword** is what I shall draw out after them. (**Ezekiel 5:12**)
- At length I said; I shall not keep shepherding **you**. The one that is dying, let her die. And the one that is being effaced, let her be effaced. And as for the ones left remaining, let them devour, each one the flesh of her companion. (**Zechariah 11:9**)
- And the ground of Judah must become to **Egypt** a cause for reeling. Everybody to whom one mentions it is in dread because of the counsel of Yehowah of armies that he is counseling against him. (**Isaiah 19:17**)
- And now **you** should positively know that by the **sword**, by the famine and by the pestilence **you will** die in the place into which **you** do delight to enter to reside as aliens. (**Jeremiah 42:22**)
- And I **will** give them into the hand of those seeking for their soul and into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon and into the hand of his servants, and afterward she **will** be resided in as in the days of old, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 46:26**)
- Son of man, set your face against Pharaoh the king of **Egypt** and prophesy against him and against **Egypt** in its entirety. (**Ezekiel 29:2**)
