- Then all the chiefs of the military forces and **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** and Jezaniah the **son** of **Hoshai** and all the people, from the smallest one even to the greatest one, approached. (**Jeremiah 42:1**)
- As for **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** and all the chiefs of the military forces who were in the field, they came to Gedaliah at Mizpah. (**Jeremiah 40:13**)
- **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** and all the chiefs of the military forces who were with him now took all the remnant of the people whom they brought back from Ishmael the **son** of Nethaniah, from Mizpah, after he had struck down Gedaliah the **son** of Ahikam, able-bodied **men**, **men** of war, and the wives and the little children and the court officials, whom he brought back from Gibeon. (**Jeremiah 41:16**)
- Abundantly our soul **has** been gluttoned with the derision of those who are at ease, of the contempt on the part of the arrogant ones. (**Psalms 123:4**)
- Has presumptuousness come? Then dishonor will come, but wisdom is with the modest ones. (**Proverbs 11:2**)
- Presumptuous, self-assuming braggart is the name of the one who is acting in a fury of presumptuousness. (**Proverbs 21:24**)
- Have you beheld a man hasty with his words? There is more hope for someone stupid than for him. (**Proverbs 29:20**)
- Let the service be heavy upon the **men** and let them work at it, and let them not pay attention to false words. (**Exodus 5:9**)
- Now, then, why have you not rebuked **Jeremiah** of Anathoth, who is behaving as a prophet to **you** people? (**Jeremiah 29:27**)

- And **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** himself said to Gedaliah, in a place of concealment in Mizpah; I want to go, now, and strike down Ishmael the **son** of Nethaniah, as no one at all will know. Why should he strike you to the soul, and why must all those of Judah who are being collected together to you be scattered and the remnant of Judah perish? (**Jeremiah 40:15**)
- In time **Johanan** the **son** of **Kareah** and all the chiefs of the military forces who were with him got to hear all the bad that Ishmael the **son** of Nethaniah had done. (**Jeremiah 41:11**)
